Year 6 Revision for SATs

We have provided each Year 6 child with the following books to take home:

- KS2 Maths Study Book + Arithmetic SAT Buster
- KS2 Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling Study Book + Spelling SAT Buster

As the titles suggest, your child should use the Study Book to study each topic before attempting the associated questions in the SAT Buster books.

HOME LEARNING

Your child will be expected to use the revision guides as part of their home learning. Please support and encourage him / her to revise "little and often" – about 20-30 minutes, at least three times a week if possible. Getting into a routine of completing **at least 3 pages each of maths and spelling**, will ensure that there are no last minute mega-revision sessions. We want the children to feel prepared – not panicked. A regular home learning routine now will also help to make the transition to secondary school much easier when it comes.

Please see overleaf for a list of excellent websites which will enable your child to have fun whilst revising. If your child does not have access to the internet at home, we will offer him / her the opportunity to use school laptops during lunchtimes.
