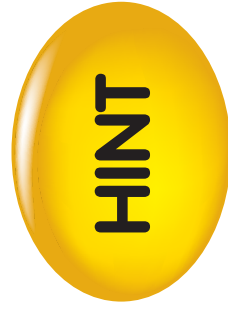
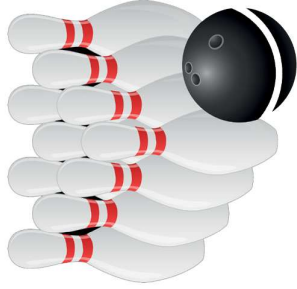


ACTIVITY 11 - TEN-PIN BOWLING

Raj and Katie went ten-pin bowling. On each turn, each child rolls 3 balls. With his first ball, Raj knocked down 2 of the skittles, 2 more with his second ball and 1 more with his 3rd. Katie knocked down 3 more skittles than Raj with her 3 balls.

How many more did Katie need to knock over to get all of the skittles down?



Start by drawing a bar to represent the ten skittles that Raj tried to knock down and the number that he did actually score. Below this, draw a bar to show how Katie did. Can you see what to do next?
