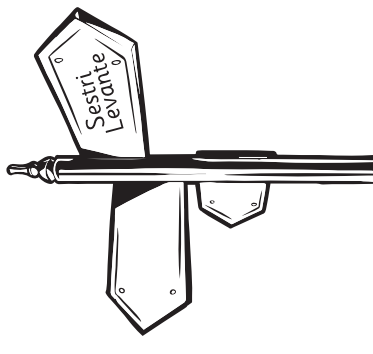


## ACTIVITY 21 - DRIVING TO ITALY
