The dots on opposite faces of a dice add up to 7.

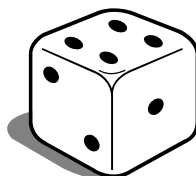
1. Imagine rolling one dice.

You score 17.

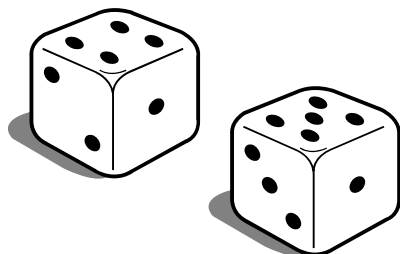
Which number is face down?
