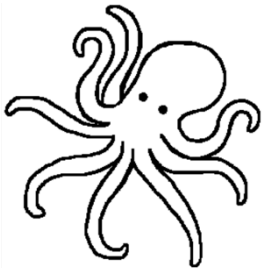
Activity: Read "Dragons and Giants from" the series Frog and Toad by Arnold Lobel or alternatively watch the story on YouTube from the link above

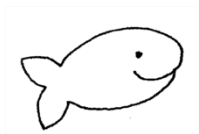
Questioning Koala (who always asks questions), asks:

Can you think of some examples of being brave and not being brave?

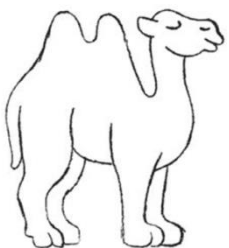
Someone who is brave will...	Someone who is not brave will...
